Passengers can carry power banks under 100Wh on airplanes in Europe without restriction. For those between 100Wh and 160Wh, airline approval is needed. Store power banks in ...

Yes, security can still ask questions, so carry printed or digital proof that shows your name, flight, power bank watt-hours and the airline contact who approved it.
