Wash or wipe a portable solar panel with water or a damp cloth just like rigid panels. If you've been on a particularly muddy camping trip, or you're using larger panels for home backup, ...

Since it's rarely possible to warm water from an outdoor spigot, a simple solution is to wash the panels early in the morning, at dusk, or on a cloudy, cool day when they are not too hot.

For residential systems, a visual inspection is recommended every 6 months and a washing of the solar panels at least once a year. In particularly dusty areas or near the sea, washing ...
