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Transmission, System and Market Operator (KOSTT) of Kosovo\* signed a contract with the Ministry of Economy and Municipality of Ferizaj, receiving 2.3 hectares of land for a 45 MW ...

Lithium-ion batteries offer a flexible, scalable solution for Kosovo's energy storage needs. For instance, a recent project in Pristina used a 10 MWh lithium battery system to reduce grid instability by 40%.

The 45 MW/90 MWh and 125 MW/250 MWh battery storage procurement exercises are initiated by the United States acting through Millennium Challenge Corp. (MCC) and Kosovo authorities.

It is the biggest investment in BESS in the Western Balkans. The first lot will be for batteries with 45 MW in capability and a duration of two hours. It translates to 90 MWh in capacity. ...
