When storing white tea, use a light-proof container so that the tea leaves are not directly exposed to sunlight. A well-sealed paper box: it is a typical and useful container for keeping white tea. However, ...

Once sealed, the Mylar bag protects the tea from moisture and light. The oxygen absorber removes oxygen from the packaging so it doesn't degrade from oxidation. Insects and their ...

Store tea in airtight, opaque containers in cool, dry, dark places away from strong odors. Most teas stay fresh 6 months to 2 years when stored properly. Don't refrigerate opened tea. Date ...
