How much does a 20 ft shipping container cost?

The current average used 20 ft shipping container costs between \$1,500 and \$3,000, and a new 20 ft container costs between \$2,500 and \$5,000. Used 40ft shipping containers cost on average \$2,000 to \$4,500 for standard and \$2,500 to \$5,000 for a 40 ft high cube, while new 40ft containers cost \$3,500 to \$6,500 and \$4,000 to \$7,000, respectively.

What size container is best for shipping?

When comparing prices for container shipping and transport, the size of the container will affect the price. While there are over a dozen different-sized containers, 20-foot (TEU) and 40-foot (FEU) containers are the most frequently used. What fits in a TEU will determine the cost of shipping.

How much does it cost to ship a 40ft container?

Drewry's World Container Index puts the global average price of shipping a 40ft container at \$2,557 (USD) for 8 January, 2026. Freightos offers a similar assessment of container shipping prices for the start of the New Year, with a global average price of \$2,502 (USD) for 9 January, 2026.
