After applying the 30% federal tax credit, net costs typically range from \$10,500 to \$24,500. Understanding solar costs requires grasping two key metrics: cost per watt and cost per kilowatt-hour (kWh).

How much do commercial solar panels cost?

Whereas the price per watt considers the solar system's size, the price per kWh shows the price of the solar system per unit of energy it produces over a given period of time. $\text{Net cost of the system} / \text{lifetime output} = \text{cost per kilowatt hour}$

How much does a monocrystalline solar system cost?
