Is Sofia the first 5G city in Bulgaria?

A1 has launched a 5G network covering central areas, residential districts and business locations in the Bulgarian capital, Sofia. It also complete the construction of a 5G network in Burgas by December 15, covering 90% of the city and making it the first fully-5G city in Bulgaria.

Is Burgas the first 5G city in Bulgaria?

What is Bulgaria doing to protect its 5G network?

Bulgaria is taking steps to protect its 5G communications networks by joining the U.S. State Department's Clean Network initiative. Additionally, the Bulgarian Association of Mobile Operators (BABTO) proposes easing access for Mobile Virtual Network Operators (MVNOs) to enter the market. Telenor Bulgaria has also released a smart monitoring platform for utilities.

Why is A1 Bulgaria launching 5G?

This allows the telco to offer gigabit broadband access and very low latency. Commenting on the development, Alexander Dimitrov, CEO of A1 Bulgaria, said: "A1 was the first to show the capabilities of 5G in the country in early 2018, and today we have launched a real working 5G network, which strengthened its leading position in technology leader.
